FEAST OF ST PETER CHANEL

The 28th of April is the liturgical feast day of St. Peter Chanel. St. Peter Chanel (1803-1841) was one of the early Marist Fathers. He was part of the first band of Marist missionaries sent from France to the missions in Oceania. He ministered on the island of Futuna where he died a martyr's death in 1841.

St. Peter Chanel was known for his gentle nature and his kindness towards everyone he met. The locals called him Petelo, 'the man with the big heart.' Pope Pius XII canonised Peter Chanel in 1954 and he is known as the proto-martyr of Oceania.

After all masses this weekend it is possible to receive a blessing with a relic of St. Peter Chanel.
