ST PETER CHANEL sm

Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> April was the feast day of St Peter Chanel sm. He was part of the first group of Marist Missionaries to sail to the new mission territory of the South West Pacific on 24<sup>th</sup> December 1836, landing at Futuna in 1837. He was martyred four years later and was canonised a saint in 1954.
