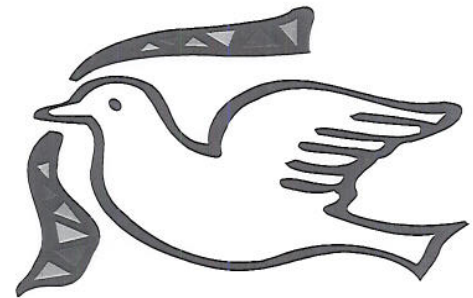

## WEEK OF GUIDEND PRAYER

It will begin on the *1<sup>st</sup> Sunday of Lent, Sunday March 9<sup>th</sup> at 7.30pm* in the Parish House, Donore Avenue. It is an opportunity to be guided in Prayer by an experienced prayer guide over a one week period. If you were to take part what would it entail for you? You would commit yourself to pray on a passage of Scripture for 20-30mins each day for 1 week. You would meet with your guide to chat over how the prayer went for you. As far as possible the one-to-one meeting will be a time that suits you. During the week people are helped to pray using Scripture & to reflect on how their prayer connects with what is happening in their daily lives. On the Opening Night the group meets & the weeks retreat is fully explained. Who can come? Anyone who would like help with prayer & is willing to give 20-30 minutes each day for 1 week.
