#### TAX REFUND IN FAVOUR OF YOUR PARISH

Support your parish via a tax refund on your donations! The Finance Act 2001 ('Scheme of Tax Relief for Donations to Charities and Eligible Bodies') allows a tax refund on donations in favour of our parish.

For the parish to benefit from this the **conditions** are:

- You must be paying income tax (either under PAYE or self-employed/self-assessment) –
- to be eligible, your donations per year are 250
  Euros or more –
- To fill out a Parish Tax Rebate Form (CHY3) to confirm the donations given and
- To give permission that the tax refund goes to our parish.

It is a simple form that the parish will provide for you. There is more information on this at the back of the church.

#### **SAFEGUARDING: ADVANCE NOTICE**

Following a review of Parish Safeguarding procedures by the Parish Safeguarding Committee last Tuesday, it is time for the parish vetting and training registers to be updated. It is the policy of the Dublin Diocese that vetting for all parish volunteers be renewed every three years. Vetting for parish volunteers in St Teresa's was last completed in 2015/16, so it is time now to renew vetting for all volunteers. In relation to safeguarding training, all those working directly with children need to renew their training. Last September 18<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> all volunteers completed the required 90 minute safeguarding information session. More information later.
