During the month of February there are many spiritually fruitful and nourishing feasts and intentions to celebrate. At the recent meeting of the liturgy committee we identified the following:

- **Friday 1st February:** Feast of St Brigid. This will be celebrated at the usual 10.00 am mass.
- **Saturday 2nd February:** Feast of The Presentation of the Lord and day of special prayer for consecrated life. This will be celebrated at the 10.00 mass. The blessing of candles will take place at the 6.30pm vigil mass that evening. Parishioners and Friends of St Teresa's parish are invited to bring and place candles in the basket at the foot of the altar to be blessed.
- **Sunday 3rd February:** Feast of St Blaise is not celebrated this year because it falls on a Sunday. However the blessing of Throats will take place after the Saturday evening vigil and Sunday morning masses.
- **Friday 8th February:** International Day of Prayer and Awareness against Human Trafficking.
- **Sunday 10th February:** On this Sunday preceding the feast of Our Lady of Lourdes, we will hold our annual Mass for the sick with the Sacrament of Anointing for the sick and elderly at the 12.30 Mass. More information later.

- **Sunday 17th February:** On this Sunday following the feast of St Valentine we pray for and celebrate our special relationships asking the intercession of St Valentine.
