### PARISH FINANCE COMMITTEE

A meeting of the Parish Finance Committee took place last Wednesday the 10<sup>th</sup> July. The meeting considered the parish income and expenditure for the first six months of 2019. It further considered this in comparison to the figures for the first six months of 2018 and in relation to our budget for 2019. This was a very re-assuring meeting, in that parish income (mostly through the weekly envelope collection) continues to meet expenditure. Plans for funding some additional future expenditure were considered, along with some issues in relation to parish property. It is possible that the proposed developments next door in the former Player Wills and adjoining sites may have an impact on Parish property. Any impact will only be agreed to if it to the advantage of and serves the mission of St Teresa's Parish and the Parishioners and Friends of St Teresa's will be informed should any such proposals materialise.
