RIO-IN-DUBLIN

Registration is now open for Rio in Dublin, which will take place from *26th-28th July*. Rio in Dublin is an exciting programme of faith & music led events, coinciding with Pope Francis's historic visit to Brazil for World Youth day 2013. The Office for Evangelisation has planned a series of exciting initiatives – including music & prayers with the Brazilian community in Dublin; a specially designed *Magis* programme encouraging young people (18+) to get involved with service initiatives; a Pilgrim walk through the city, concerts, workshops & late night live video link to Rio for the events with Pope Francis. LOURDES 2013

Dublin Diocesan Pilgrimage is from *Sept 7th – 12th* under the leadership of the Archbishop of Dublin. Parishioners may join the pilgrimage, *as Associates*, by being enrolled & by making a voluntary donation. The money collected will be devoted to defraying the expenses of the Sick Pilgrims Section. Parishioners will receive in return, as Associates, an enrolment leaflet outlining the prayers for Associates. The enrolment sheets containing the names of the Associates will be placed at the Grotto during the Pilgrimage. Mass will be offered for all the Associate Members at the Grotto in Lourdes. *Mrs Jean McDonald*, Sandford Gardens, has kindly agreed to act as a Promoter for Donore Avenue Parish.

PARISH FINANCE COMMITTEE

* Mahony Bros will commence *painting the central aisle of the Church on Mon July 15th*. They will also *mark out the Car park & provide 2 spaces for disabled drivers*.
* We are trying to agree a deal for *cushion seating in the Church* - hopefully we will make progress over the next week. The provision of padded seating may assist parishioners who may find it difficult to sit for a long period of time in the pew.

PARISH DISABILITY AUDIT REPORT

The main recommendations were

- * Car parking spaces made available & clearly marked out, near the church for disabled drivers
- * To allow for full independent access for a wheelchair user or for a person with a loss in upper body mobility, it would be a recommendation to have an automatic or power assisted entrance door.
- * People with a disability need to know in advance when coming to a church for a funeral, wedding etc. if the church is accessible. It would be recommended to have signs on the outside of the church visible from the road denoting facilities that are available e.g. wheelchair access, loop, accessible toilet.
- * The provision of some padded seating with armrests would assist a person who may find it difficult to sit for a long period of time in the pew & who may need support in rising to an upright position.
- * A directional sign for the toilet from the church would be recommended & handrails fitted in the toilet.
- * Missalettes: please take into consideration the Deaf in the community who would like to see the Eucharistic Prayers included in the missalette.
- * It is recommended to have available on bookstand large print Mass Books.
- * When parish website is being undertaken please consider making the website itself accessible & giving details of access within the church & church buildings
- * A notice should be displayed on the porch notice-board inviting persons with coeliac to make themselves known to the priest of the parish to ensure that they are accommodated
- * For the future you may consider having a web cam fitted in the church.
- * An arrangement whereby a sign interpreter & texts in Braille are available on request & the parishioners are made aware of this service – see notice-board.
- * There is very little colour contrast between the floor covering & the seating. For a person with a visual impairment poor lighting or glare can be disorientating. It is a help to have a 'wayfinding'. A marking on the outside of the seats or along the floor is a help to guide the visually impaired to ascertain where they are in the church.
