The Celtic Spirituality Programme Croí Nua which ran very successfully last summer is being run again for a second time. WMOF TICKETS (PHOENIX PARK)

The parish has pre-booked 70 adult, 35 children's tickets (for those under 18, and must be used in conjunction with an adult ticket) and 6 disability tickets (enables the person to bring one carer on their ticket) for the Papal Mass in the Phoenix Park. They are expected to be available at the end of July. Sam will be taking names and booking people for these tickets and provide printed tickets when they become available. A list to apply for tickets will be kept in the sacristy.

COURSES IN THEOLOGY

The study of theology can help to gain a deeper understanding of our Christian faith and its place in contemporary society. Studying theology is not just for priests or religious. Quite a few places offer courses in theology in and around Dublin. The Loyola Institute (TCD) offers an MPhil in Christian Theology which aims to help students to gain an in-depth knowledge of core issues in contemporary Christian theology.
