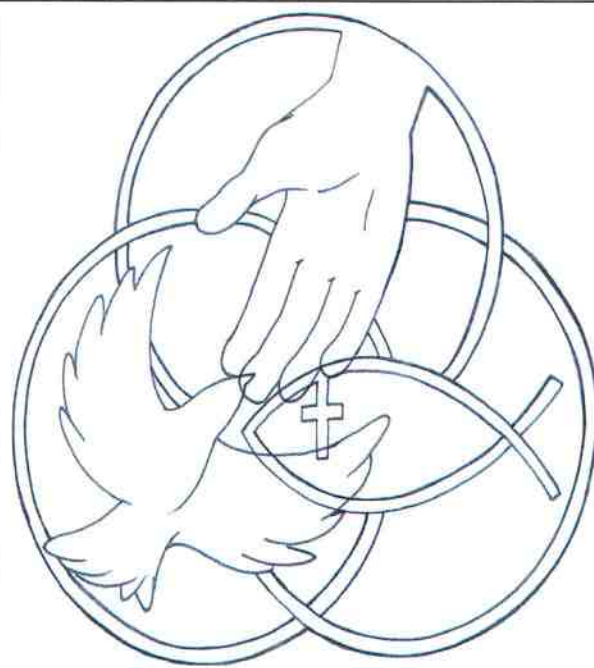

SUMMER PILGRIMAGES

Last Tuesday a group from St. Teresa's went on pilgrimage to Knock. The parish offers two more opportunities to go on pilgrimage during the summer:

CLONMACNOISE PILGRIMAGE

We will visit Clonmacnoise on **Thursday 25th July, departing at 11am and returning in the evening.** The cost of this trip is €40 with lunch included. Booking forms are on the green sheets at the back of the Church. Please book early to avoid disappointment. **Please return to Sam with full payment before Tuesday 16th July.**

Clonmacnoise is an ancient monastic site near Shannonbridge, County Offaly, and is a top visitor attraction in Ireland. A walk amongst the peaceful stone ruins of this famous place will conjure images of the saints and scholars of Ireland's renowned Golden Age of learning. Founded by St Ciaran in the mid-6th century, it became a great centre of religion and learning, visited by scholars from all over the world. Today, the site exists as a preserved ruin and visitors can see three high crosses, a cathedral, seven churches and two round towers.

LOUGH DERG PILGRIMAGE

Our annual pilgrimage to the beautiful Lough Derg Shrine which is dedicated to St. Patrick will take place on **Tuesday 20th August, departing at 6.30am and returning that evening.** The cost of this trip is €85 with lunch and dinner included. (Lough Derg charge €40pp to enter the island) **Booking forms are on the cream sheets at the back of the Church.** Please book early to avoid disappointment. Please return to Sam with full payment before Tuesday 13th August.

Stories about Lough Derg and the legendary pilgrimage have spanned the centuries as far back as records go, with the spirituality of St Patrick being remembered and renewed every year by pilgrims. For over 1500 years pilgrims have come to Lough Derg and remarkably the Island continues to hold its appeal for young and old alike with people continuing to come for all kinds of reasons. Some come to reflect on life changing decisions, to come to terms with where they are at, to give thanks to God for joy in their lives, to overcome loss, to pray for themselves or a loved one.
