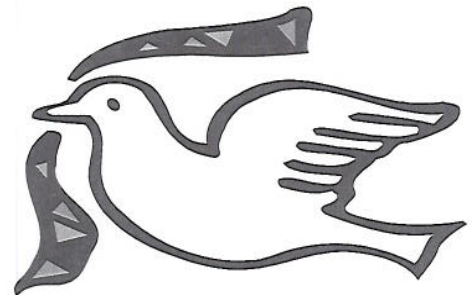

"Love is of the essence of Christian life, because God loved us first. The commandment of love of neighbour, grounded in the love that God first showed us, is clearly a responsibility for individual Christians. But it is also a responsibility to be developed in an appropriate way by the entire ecclesial community at every level & at every time in its history. For the church, charity is not a kind of welfare activity which could be equally well left to others, but is a part of her nature, an indispensable expression of her very being. The practice of love must be a distinctive mark of every expression of the life of the Church. Each year, on the feast of St Peter & St Paul, we hold a special collection for the Charitable Work of the Holy Father, Pope Francis & his Papal Charities. The collection will be taken up at all Masses in the Diocese on the weekend of *Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> June*. It replaces the Share Collection" (Archbishop Diarmuid Martin)
