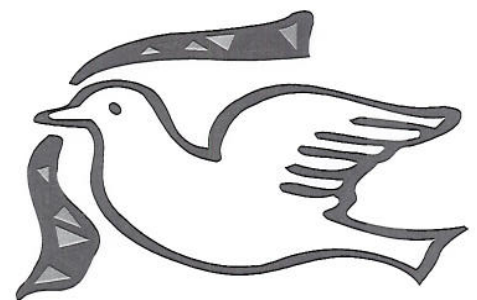

ANNUAL PETER'S PENCE COLLECTION

“Love is of the essence of Christian life, because God loved us first. The commandment of love of neighbour, grounded in the love that God first showed us, is clearly a responsibility for individual Christians. But it is also a responsibility to be developed in an appropriate way by the entire ecclesial community at every level & at every time in its history. For the church, charity is not a kind of welfare activity which could be equally well left to others, but is a part of her nature, an indispensable expression of her very being. The practice of love must be a distinctive mark of every expression of the life of the Church. Each year, on the feast of St Peter & St Paul, we hold a special collection for the Charitable Work of the Holy Father, Pope Francis & his Papal Charities. The collection will be taken up at all Masses in the Diocese on the weekend of *Sunday 29th June*. It replaces the Share Collection” (Archbishop Diarmuid Martin)
