### COMMUNION SERVICE DURING LENT

As you see in the "Lent & Holy Week in our Parish" Leaflet, there are Communion Services on three Thursday evenings during Lent at 7.30pm. What is a Communion Service? It is a lay led liturgy focusing on the word of God, and a word of reflection, with the opportunity of receiving the Eucharist. Communion Services are included as an element of the Parish Pastoral Plan and it has been an aspiration of the parish to introduce this form of liturgy, which is already a practice in other parishes. Our pastoral assistant, Sam, will lead the Communion Service. It counts as the liturgy for the day.

### STATIONS OF THE CROSS DURING LENT

Every Friday morning, at 9.40am, before the 10am mass, we will pray the Stations of the Cross. This is a very appropriate devotion in the Lenten season.

### **TRÓCAIRE**

The theme for the Trocaire campaign 2020 is "Help Women to Protect their Families"

The traditional Trócaire boxes are available at the back of the church. As well as being a means of fund-raising for the work of Trócaire, they are also a very valuable awareness raising symbol for the needs of the wider church and society. These boxes can be returned to the parish at the Mass of the Lords Supper on Holy Thursday night or afterwards, for delivery to Trócaire.

# COVID 19 CORONAVIRUS HSE GUIDANCE FOR RELIGIOUS SERVICES

The Archdiocese of Dublin and all Parishes have received the above general advice about preventing the spread of COVID – 19 during religious services. This advice and guidance for the wellbeing and health of everybody.

The specific changes in practices include the following:

- Not to shake hands as an expression of the sign of peace or on greeting or departing from services.
- Only receive Holy Communion in the hands and not on the tongue.
- Eucharist Ministers wash hands or use hand gel before distribution of communion.
- Not to use the Holy Water Font.
- Only the main celebrant should drink from the chalice.

Hand wash dispensers have been installed at the entrance to the church, to the sacristy and to the parish house. Tissues and bins for the disposal of tissues are also available in the church.

The full guidance from the HSE is available on display at the back of the church.

The parish / diocese will continue to update you on best practice in this regard.
