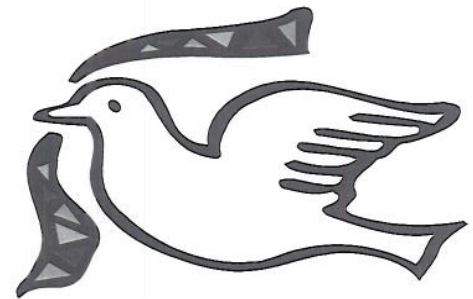

The season of Lent begins on Weds March 5th, *Ash Wednesday*, a day of fast & abstinence. Masses @ 10am & 7.30pm, ashes will be distributed after each Mass. Throughout the season, Mon-Sat, *Morning Prayer of the Church* will be celebrated @ 9.45am.

WALKING THE ROAD OF RECONCILIATION

The Parish Liturgy Group are inviting parishioners to be part of a 7 step process of reconciliation which encourages daily reflection on one line of scripture, a thought from Pope Francis & a brief daily prayer. Some positive action is also suggested inspired by the words & images relevant to the phrase from the Bible. The 1st step is taken on Ash Wednesday when parishioners are invited to walk the road of reconciliation by taking a bookmark, with the scripture quotation, the thought, the action & the daily prayer. A new card is given out on each of the 5 Sundays of Lent following the same format. The final step will be the celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation on Tuesdav. April 15th @ 7.30pm.
