

## CHURCH NOTICE: Phones, Eating, Talking

Please be assured that the new notice concerning Mobile Phones, Eating and Drinking and not talking during ceremonies, in the church, is in no way, intended or directed towards those who regularly attend St Teresa's.

It is intended and directed towards visitors to the church who are no longer familiar with good practice and etiquette in a religious setting. It is a reality these days that, unfortunately, we have to bring such things to the attention of those who only very irregularly attend the church and are no longer familiar with appropriate ways of behaving.

## CORONAVIRUS: HSE GUIDANCE FOR RELIGIOUS SERVICES

The specific changes in practices include the following:

- Not to shake hands as an expression of the sign of peace or on greeting or departing from services.
- Only receive Holy Communion in the hands and not on the tongue.
- Eucharist Ministers wash hands or use hand gel before distribution of communion.
- Not to use the Holy Water Font.
- Only the main celebrant should drink from the chalice.

Hand wash dispensers have been installed at the entrance to the church, the sanctuary and to the parish house. Tissues and bins for the disposal of tissues are also available.

The full guidance from the HSE is available on display at the back of the church.

The parish / diocese will continue to update you on best practice in this regard.
