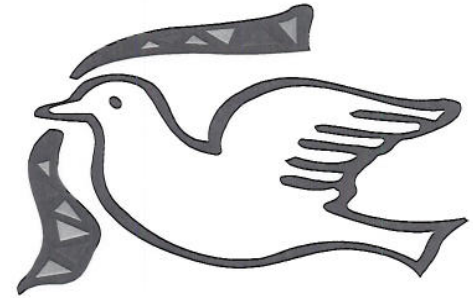

#### *WALKING THE ROAD OF RECONCILIATION*

The Parish Liturgy Group are inviting parishioners to be part of a 7 step process of reconciliation which encourages daily reflection on one line of scripture, a thought from Pope Francis & a brief daily prayer. Some positive action is also suggested inspired by the words & images relevant to the phrase from the Bible. The 1<sup>st</sup> step is taken on Ash Wednesday when parishioners are invited to walk the road of reconciliation by taking a bookmark, with the scripture quotation, the thought, the action & the daily prayer. A new card is given out on each of the 5 Sundays of Lent following the same format. The final step will be the celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation on *Tues, April 15<sup>th</sup> @ 7.30pm*. Each Sunday, after Holy Communion, the Reader will read the thought from Pope Francis & the positive action.

#### APPLICATIONS FOR PERMANENT DIACONATE

Permanent Diaconate is a voluntary ordained ministry, normally exercised a part-time capacity. The diocese of Dublin currently has 11 permanent deacons & 11 candidates in formation. The formation programme includes a preliminary year, 3 further years before ordination & 2 years after ordination. Applications are invited from men of faith between 35 -60 years, who already have some track record of service in their parish or community. *Apply by 31<sup>st</sup> March*.
