## LENT 2019

### EVENING MASS EACH NIGHT

During the weekdays of Lent, mass is celebrated at 10am and 7.30pm. Just bear in mind that there will be no evening mass on Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> April (Lenten reflection evening), and Tuesday 16<sup>th</sup> April (penitential service).

### STATIONS OF THE CROSS

During the season of Lent, the Stations of the Cross are said each Friday morning at 9.40am prior to the 10am mass.

### LENTEN & EASTER DATES

A booklet with all the information and times for Lent and Easter is now available at the back of the church. Please take one home for yourselves and also for any neighbours or friends who you think might like one.

### LENTEN SYMBOLS

To emphasise the beginning of lent, some features have been added to the sanctuary. Over the season of Lent and culminating in Easter Sunday Resurrection, further features will be added to various parts of the church.

### TROCAIRE BOXES

Trocaire Boxes continue to be available at the back of the church or in the sacristy. You are invited to take one per household as a means of uniting your Lenten sacrifice with your donation to those less fortunate around the world. Trocaire boxes can be returned to the parish during Holy Week for forwarding to Trocaire or can be forwarded directly to them.

### MINISTERS OF THE WORD FOR THE EASTER CEREMONIES

Like previous years Ministers of the Word are invited to volunteer times and days when they are available to read at the various services over Holy Week. Envelopes are available for collection in the sacristy for all Ministers of the Word.

### HYMN BOOKS AND NUMBER BOARDS

New Lenten Hymn Books are now available for use during parish masses and services. Some new hymns have been added. Also two new Hymn Number Boards have been installed in the church. These will carry the numbers for the hymns to be used at the Saturday evening mass and the eleven mass on Sunday morning.

## SAFEGUARDING

The parish safeguarding audit will be submitted to the Dublin Diocese this week by our two parish Safeguarding representatives Alice O’Connell and Breda O’Hara. One of the actions necessary to meet the requirements of the Audit and in order to be in compliance with Dublin Diocesan Safeguarding Policy is for all volunteers to renew their “Garda Vetting” this year and also for those working directly with children to renew their safeguarding training. Both of these are being addressed at the moment.

## BAPTISM MEETING

The next Baptism Preparation Meeting for parents of children to be baptised during April will take place on Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> April at 8pm in the parish house. At the moment there are six families who made baptism bookings for April, two of which are for baptism at the 11am mass on Easter Sunday morning.
