EVENING MASS EACH NIGHT

During the weekdays of Lent, mass is celebrated at 10am and 7.30pm. Just bear in mind that there will be no evening mass on Thursday 11th April (Lenten reflection evening), and Tuesday 16th April (penitential service).

STATIONS OF THE CROSS

One of the actions necessary to meet the requirements of the Audit and in order to be in compliance with Dublin Diocesan Safeguarding Policy is for all volunteers to renew their "Garda Vetting" this year and also for those working directly with children to renew their safeguarding training. Both of these are being addressed at the moment.
