CHANGES IN PREVIOUSLY ANNOUNCED COLLECTIONS

Due to an announcement from the Dublin Diocese we have had to make some changes to previously announced special collections.

The special collection for the training of priests (Vocations) that would normally take place this Sunday (11th & 12th May) has been cancelled, as the diocese has sufficient funding for the training of priests at the moment.

The diocese, however, will be holding a special collection the following weekend (18th & 19th May) MINISTRY SUNDAY for the "Passing on of the Faith and Support for Lay Ministry", in short: the training of Lay people for Ministry. This will replace the share collection that weekend.

There are leaflets and posters at the back of the church with further information about this initiative to raise funds for the training and support of Lay Ministry in the Diocese.

As a consequence of this change we have had to postpone again the visit of Sr Nuala, a Franciscan Missionary, for a mission appeal. She will now come to our parish on the 13th and 14th July.
