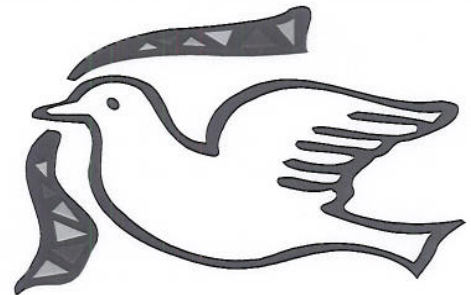

SPECIAL COLLECTION FOR SYRIA & THE PHILIPPINES

The collection this weekend will be for humanitarian work in Syria & the Philippines. The collection will be for both disasters: 50% going to relief in Syria & 50% for immediate relief in the Philippines.

The United Nations estimate that almost 10 million have been affected by super-typhoon Haiyan in *the Philippines* & more than 5 million people left homeless. The damage is catastrophic. Trocaire's partner, Catholic Relief Services has sent rapid assessment teams to the area. 8,000 tarpaulins are currently being distributed to provide shelter for survivors. Agencies working on the ground are also assessing water & sanitation needs to prevent the spread of water-borne diseases, which will be one of the immediate threats to survivors. Irish public donations will be used to provide water, food, shelter & medicines to those who are most affected.

In Syria, over 8.4 million people – approx half of whom are children – are in need of humanitarian assistance. Approx 5.8 million people have been forced to abandon their homes, with 2.1 million people seeking refuge in the neighbouring countries of Lebanon, Turkey, Jordan, Iraq & Egypt. More than 50% of registered refugees are children. If current trends persist, it can be expected that over 3.5 million Syrians will have left their country by the end of 2013 – putting an enormous burden on the refugee-hosting countries. With Caritas, in response to the crisis, Trocaire has been delivering vital emergency aid since 2011 to over 273,000 people in Syria & neighbouring countries. The contributions from this special collection will help to get food, water, clothing, shelter, medical & psycho-social supports to those most in need.
