We have booked the diocesan trainer for the two nights of Tuesday 18th and Thursday 20th of September and we ask each parish volunteer to register for one of the nights. A sign-on list is available in the sacristy. Our two parish safeguarding representatives, Breda O'Hara and Alice O'Connell, have a separate training day on the 8th of September. Safeguarding of children and vulnerable adults in the church is everybody's responsibility but is a particular responsibility for those who in some way are seen as representing the church.
