Last Thursday was the last meeting for the Croí Nua Programme. A group of 10 people participated in this adult faith development programme. The parish team is exploring possibilities to offer further opportunities for adult faith development in the parish. More information to follow.

SAFEGUARDING - PARISH TRAINING

The Dublin Diocese Safeguarding procedures include that all parish volunteers avail of a session of safeguarding training. Parish volunteers include the following: Ministers of the Word and Eucharist, Altar Society and Church Cleaners, Finance Committee (incl. counters, church & street collectors), Liturgy Committee, Parish Pastoral Council, Sacristans, musicians, choir members and other parish volunteers. We have booked the diocesan trainer for the two nights of Tuesday 18th and Thursday 20th of September 7.30pm and we ask each parish volunteer to register for one of the nights. A sign-on list is available in the sacristy. Our two parish safeguarding representatives, Breda O'Hara and Alice O'Connell, have a separate training day on the 8th of September. Safeguarding of children and vulnerable adults in the church is everybody's responsibility but is a particular responsibility for those who in some way are seen as representing the church.

FAITH FOR LIFE

Faith for Life is an adult faith course designed to help you to discover more energising and empowering ways to live out your faith in the reality of today's world through relationships, family, home, workplaces and the events of daily life. It aims to help you to be more active, open, faithful, confident, trusting and willing to work for change. The Faith for Life course is experienced as a journey of four 'Movements' inviting you to explore the call you received in Baptism. The process for each weekend includes teaching, personal and group reflection, prayer and liturgy. The course is run over four weekends: 6/7 October 2018, 17/18 November 2018, 12/13 January 2019 and 23/24 February 2019. This course has been designed and is delivered through a partnership agreement between the Archdioceses of Dublin and Liverpool. Upon completion, participants will be awarded a Certificate of Achievement.
