NATIONAL PILGRIM STATUE OF OUR LADY OF FATIMA IN THE PARISH

It is a beautiful hand-carved image of Our Lady given to Ireland by the bishop of Fatima and blessed by Pope Paul VI in 1967. The statue is currently in the **chapel of the Missionaries of Charity (223 South Circular Road)** until November 28th 2018. The statue is accompanied by the **relics of St. Francisco Marto and St. Jacinta Marto** (two of the children to whom Our Lady appeared).
