'If only you knew what God is offering and who it is that is saying to you: Give me a drink, you would have been the one to ask, and he would have given you living water' (John 5:7)

'Let us go forth to offer everyone the life of Jesus Christ.... so many of our brothers and sisters are living without the strength, light and consolation born of friendship with Jesus Christ, without a community to support them, without meaning and a goal in life.' (E.G. 49)



MONDAY 24

'Send forth your light and your truth; let these be my guide' (Psalm 41)

'Each Christian and every community must discern the path that the Lord points out, but all of us are asked to obey his call to go forth from our own comfort zone in order to reach all the peripheries in need of the light of the Gospel.' (E.G. 20)



'Give me time, the servant said, and I will pay the whole sum I owe. And the servant's master felt so sorry for him that he let him go and cancelled the debt' (Matthew 18:26-7)

'A globalisation of indifference has developed. 'Before all else, the Gospel invites us to respond to the God of love who saves us, to see God in others and to go forth from ourselves to seek the good of others.' (E.G. 39)


