Dear Parishioners,

Dublin, Ireland has been chosen by Pope Francis to host the next World Meeting of Families in August 2018. Started by Saint John Paul II, and held every three years, this major world event celebrates family as the cornerstone of our lives, and the fundamental building bocks of our society and the Church. Families and others from all over the world will gather in Dublin from 21st -26th August 2018 to celebrate their lives together, to share their experiences from different parts of the world, to reflect on different challenges they face and to grow in faith.

The theme chosen by Pope Francis for WMOF2018 is the Gospel of the Family: Joy for the World. The WMOF2018 logo, launched in December 2016, reflects on this theme and our journey towards August 2018.

Programme for World Meeting of Families 2018

<u>Tuesday 21st August:</u> Opening Ceremonies in all diocese across Ireland and in the RDS

<u>Wed 22nd – Fri 24th August:</u> Three-day Congress, held in the RDS. An exciting series of major panels, workshops, keynote speakers, testimonies and activities, each day of the Pastoral Congress will explore themes from *The Joy of Love*. There will also be dedicated youth and children's programmes available for the three days.

<u>Fri 25th August:</u> Festival of Families in Croke Park, Dublin. This is a celebration of family life around the world that will feature musical and dance performances, as well as five selected families from around the world giving witness to their family's faith. The Festival of Families is a **free ticketed event**. Every person in attendance will require a ticket to access the venue. Tickets will be limited subject to venue capacity and availability.

Petition Box

At the National launch of the preparations for the World Meeting of Families, each diocese was presented with a prayer petition box which will remain in that diocese for the remainder of the year. As the Icon of the Holy Family visits different parishes throughout Ireland it will be accompanied by the petition box of that Diocese for the duration of its stay.



All the contemplative communities around the country have agreed to take a share of these petitions throughout the year and to pray for each individual petition received. In June next year all the petitions will be collected from the contemplative communities and they will be brought to the final Mass for WMOF 2018.

In St. Teresa's we will create our own petition box which will be placed in our church and regularly emptied. These petitions will be brought to of the one contemplative orders by Sam our pastoral assistant to have our prayers ioined with others preparing for WMOF 2018.



Trócaire Romero Family Award

Trócaire is calling upon all parishes in Ireland to take on the Romero Awards as part of their preparation for WMOF. Inspired by Blessed Oscar Romero and his concern for the poor and oppressed, the Romero award aims to provide you and your family with an avenue to learn about the lives of other families around the world where Trócaire works. You will learn about their daily lives, the issues that they face and share in their hopes and dreams for the future. Each participating family will receive a certificate and a solidarity gift from a country where Trócaire works. They will also be invited to an awards ceremony that coincides with the celebrations at the World Meeting of Families gathering in Dublin next August 2018, as well as being entered into a draw to win an eco-friendly 'Green Family trip' to the Slieve Aughty Centre, Co. Galway.

In the Joy of Love Pope Francis says that Valentine's day is an opportunity for couples to celebrate the depth and beauty of romantic love in a way that goes beyond commercial interests. What gift will you bring to your loved one this Valentine's Day? How about a gift of your time and attention?

In 'The Joy of Love, a letter from Pope Francis to the world', he emphasises the fundamental importance of time together and personal communication as foundations for a love that lasts. So instead of buying a gift for each other, couples could commit to time together – a meal, a walk, a remembrance of how they met, and so on.

Given that St. Valentine's day falls this year on Ash Wednesday this is a good year to think outside the chocolate box!

A gift created by WMOF is a non-commercial gift token which can be given to a loved one that focuses on quality time together. Each token entitles the recipient to one of a number of gifts including:
