### RELAIS MARISTE AT TINOS, EASTER IN GREECE, 21-28 APRIL

Relais mariste is a group of Marists, both lay and religious and their families and friends, who organise opportunities for holidays which include a faith dimension. Hubert Bonnet-Eymard (Fr) writes: "The idea of a Relais mariste event in Greece has been in the air for a long time. At the end of our week in August 2017, Alexandra Yannicopoulos-Boulet proposed a project to spend Holy Week on the island of Tinos, in the Cyclades in 2019. The island is known as a place of Marian devotion for the Orthodox and Catholic traditions ever since the presence of the Venetians on the island. 16 adults participated. All the ingredients of Relais mariste were there: friendship,



kindness, humour, recreation, and prayer – the Eucharist, Gospel sharing, the Novena to St Pierre Chanel. Added to this was the pleasure of discovering or rediscovering, the Greece of today. We had a taste of its historical and



mythological culture and of course, we discovered the impact of the recent economic crisis on its people. Who could forget also the harsh reality experienced by thousands of migrants from the East or South, stranded there, often in conditions of extreme hardship? Fr Maurice Joyeux, a Jesuit, welcomed us to this ancient pilgrimage centre in the mountains. Thanks to the tenacity of Alexandra and her energy, a long-standing dream has become a reality and we are ready for new adventures!"

# MARIST PILGRIMAGE TO SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA,

Frank Dowling, Provincial Education Deputy, recently led a group of teachers and former teachers from Marist schools on pilgrimage to Compostela. He writes: "In Holy Week our group of 10 set out to walk the final 110 km of the Camino de Santiago from Sarria to Santiago. We set off each day at 07h45 just as it was getting light and walked between 20 and 25 km each day. We tried to arrive at our destination around 15h but due to a wide divergence in both age and fitness level, individual arrival times varied considerably! The project was a proposal supported by the Heads of the Education centres in Europe as a means of promoting inter-school contacts and cooperation. Our common Marist heritage proved a unifying factor. New ideas to promote the Marist Ethos and characteristic spirit in the education ministry was a recurring theme of our conversations."
