## **FORMATION OF FORMATORS**

In August a workshop for Formators will take place in Rome, gathering confreres currently involved or expected to be involved in formation programmes of the Society. There will be 19 participants, coming from all continents. The workshop, which will be hosted at the General House, takes place from 14 to 31 August and is coordinated by Fr Larry Duffy, with the help of Frs Paul Walsh and David Sanchez.

Before the start of the workshop, a small group of participants will spend two weeks at la Neylière and Belley while visiting our Marist Places of Origin in France.

## WORLD GATHERING OF MARIST LAITY IN IRELAND

In Dublin, from the 2-4 August, 22 delegates from 11 different countries will represent the World-wide Marist Laity Coordination. This is a follow-up meeting from the one in los Negrales, Spain, which gave rise to the WMLC. The delegates will reflect on a range of issues, including mission, organizational structure, commitment, formation, finance, communications and directories, with a view to build on the impetus given to Marist Laity at the 2017 General Chapter, and to consolidate the work that has been done over the past few years. Fr Paul Walsh, s.m., who has special responsibility for accompanying Marist Laity in the General Council will attend. As with the los Negrales event, this weekend meeting of world delegates is preceded by a 5-day gathering of Marist laity delegates organized by the European Marist laity Coordination. Fr John Larsen, Superior General, will address this gathering.

## BLESSING OF A CENTER FOR MEDICAL CARE IN CHIAPAS, MEXICO



During the patron Saint's feast in the parish of *San Fermín* at la Independencia, Chiapas, Mexico, bishop Rodrigo Aguilar Martínez, bishop of San Cristobal de las Casas, blessed and inaugurated a center for medical care, which is attached to the parish house where our confreres live. The new

built medical center hosts 2 projects: a dental care unit where the parishioners who cannot afford expensive dental care are helped by professional dentists; and a unit where women of the local community run a natural medicine and herbs laboratory. The construction of the health center was partially financed by the General Administration's Special Projects Fund.
