## **Report from Monteverde**

Fr Pat Devlin, the Superior of the General House, reports:

"At Villa Santa Maria we have been following the government requirements for the last two weeks. We are confined to the property unless we need to go out for food or medical needs. We are also following the instructions of the Pope and our local Church to live this moment with prudence, solidarity and a spirit of faith, although the restrictions do not apply because we do not have a public chapel or ministry.

For the health of our lay staff we have reduced their need to be physically on our property and much of their office work is being done from home. All of us need a travel document for moving around the city. As of today, no member of Villa Santa Maria, confreres, sisters or laity, has become sick. We continue to take the recommended precautions so that we may continue our ministry of administration and study."
