GUIDANCE FOR PUBLIC MASS

A big thank you to everyone following the guidance. The recent restrictions remind us to continue to take it seriously to be able to celebrate mass together. #Use hand sanitisers, stay in your seats for communion, entrance/exit doors, use the safe for the collections, do not kneel when people sit in the pew before you, the toilet is not available. #The church is thoroughly sprayed to keep it disinfected. High touch points are cleaned daily.

<u>Face covering</u> is obligatory in most indoor places. <u>Places of worship are not explicitly mentioned.</u> However, we highly recommend to wear a face covering for mass attendance.

Stewards: We thank the volunteers to help us during Sunday masses. Please follow their guidance. As we reviewed the situation we need to remind people: Use the one way system, do not kneel with people in the pew in front, do not use the toilets.

<u>MASS INTENTIONS</u>: By way of precaution around the restrictions on numbers allowed inside the church, we are limiting each mass to only one intention for the moment.

PARISH WEBCAM

The webcam is installed and is available to view via a link on our parish website.

OPEN CHURCH: The church is open every day for mass and private prayer until 1pm.

CONFESSION:

After the 10am mass on Saturdays, a priest will be available in the back of the church for the sacrament of reconciliation (only as long as people are coming forward).

<u>CONFIRMATION:</u> We have been approached by a family in the parish to hold an additional ceremony for their child and maybe a small number of others who live within the boundary of St Teresa's parish. We have discussed this with the relevant parish and hope to hold a confirmation ceremony during the 12.30pm mass on Sunday August 16th.

FUNERALS: Attendance is now widened to up to 50 members of close family. People standing outside the church before and after funerals honouring the deceased are asked to keep the social distance of two metres between each other.
