A plenary indulgence is also gained by visiting a cemetery and praying for the dead on the above conditions in the time from 1 to 8 November.

SERVICE OF REMEMBRANCE for CHILDREN lost before, during, or after BIRTH:

Sometime during November, the parish will place a liturgy on our Website, Facebook and Webcam pages, to remember all children lost before, during or after birth and to express our sympathy for their parents. We are in the process of filming this and will give more information in the next newsletter.

ANNUAL MASS FOR THE DECEASED 15 November

Unfortunately, as we are unable to have public mass at the moment, we will only be able to hold this mass online this year, through the webcam. The families of all those who died from the parish in the past year, will be contacted and invited to participate by means of the webcam. We will write to all the families and deliver a booklet with the words of the ceremony for use at home. We will read out the names to honour all those who passed away and who mourn for them. The tree with the names will be visible via webcam and for personal prayer in the afternoon. You will find the names of those deceased over the last year in this newsletter.

THE NOVEMBER TREE OF REMEMBRANCE will remain for this month in the alcove beside the shrine to St Peter Chanel. You are invited to write the name of your deceased relatives and friends on the labels and to hang them on the tree, for prayerful remembrance by the parishioners and friends of St Teresa's. Please observe all social distancing guidelines while writing and placing the names on the tree.

NOVEMBER LIST OF THE DEAD envelopes are now available. Envelopes can be handed to one of the parish team, into the sacristy or parish house. The envelopes with the list of names will be opened by the priests. During the year a mass is offered each week for all those whose names are on the altar list of the dead. The names are placed on the altar for each of these masses.
