CHRISTMAS MASSES

As a parish we continue to reflect on how best to manage masses on Christmas Eve and Christmas Day. There is an expectation (based on the experience of other years) that the congregations for these masses will be considerably larger than normal.

In order to fulfil the public health guidance in relation to COVID 19, and also to fittingly celebrate Christmas, the Archbishop is asking parishes to consider Christmas as a twelve day festival. And therefore to consider attending mass at some stage during these twelve days and maybe to visit the crib with young family members at other quiet times during the day.

As a minimum we will have our normal four Christmas masses at 6pm and 9pm on Christmas Eve and at 9.30am and 11am on Christmas Day. Whether we offer an early morning Christmas day mass at 8am and / or one at 12.30pm has not been decided yet. We welcome your views on this.

BAPTISM: Please contact the parish house about baptisms in 2021 to be held on the first and third Saturdays of the month at 2pm. These will be held in accordance with the public health restrictions of the time. Numbers for each family are limited to 10. There are baptisms during December 2020.
