GRADUAL EASING OF RESTRICTIONS

Welcome back! Especially to anyone returning to day after a long while, or after vaccination or just feeling that the time is right to return.

Reminder of Covid 19 measures for our safety:

- Max. number of 90 people
- two meter social distancing
- wearing a mask
- sanitizing of hands in and out
- communion in the pew
- do not kneel if there is a person in front
- take the mass leaflet home with you or dispose of it in the bin at the exits.
- use the one way system entrance/exit.

Many thanks to those who volunteer to guide us in all this as stewards for each mass. Please bring anything you notice or feel uncomfortable about to the attention of the stewards.

Mass is still available online for those who feel safer to stay at home. Because the church is disinfected regularly and thoroughly, we need only to clean the high touch points and to ventilate the church after each mass. Mass times remain at the usual times of 6.30pm (Saturday) and 10am, 11am and 12.30pm on Sundays. The church is open from 9am to 5pm each day.

BAPTISMS, WEDDINGS, and FUNERALS:

Please contact the parish house for questions.

Weddings: Maximum number: 50

Funerals: Maximum number: 50. On request from the family, funeral services can be recorded via the webcam. This recording will be kept for one week and then erased.

Baptisms: The Archdiocese issued a statement **not** to have baptisms in June respecting public health guidance. In light of the further reopening of society on the 5th July, we have received a further statement from the Archdiocese permitting baptisms from then on. We have bookings for the months of July, August and September and are now in a position to fulfil these. The baptisms originally scheduled for June will be rearranged.

In relation to the celebration of any sacraments, the Archbishop offers the following guidance:

“As you know, the more serious concerns relate to the social gatherings which typically follow the celebration of these sacraments. It should be stressed to families that these events must be planned in line with prevailing public health advice on household mixing and indoor and outdoor gatherings, for the health and safety of all concerned.”
