Funerals: Maximum number is still 50. On request from the family, funeral services can be recorded via the webcam. This recording will be kept for one week.

Baptisms: The next celebration of Parish baptisms is on Saturday 4th September. Bookings are being taken for baptisms each month for the first and third Saturday. The next available free dates are in November. For the foreseeable future, attendance at baptisms is being limited to 10 people per baptism. In the context of covid-19 smaller groups reduce the mixing of households and it also contributes to a more meaningful ceremony.
