HEALTH AND SAFETY

From September 6th, the following health guidance applies for, Religious services and ceremonies (for example Baptisms, First Communions, Confirmations, Weddings & Funerals). *"They can proceed with 50% of venue capacity, regardless of immunity status of attendees. (Subject to appropriate protective measures including social distancing as much as possible, hand sanitising, face masks etc).*

All other measures designed to minimise necessary physical interaction during services should be maintained".

50% of the capacity of St Teresa's is 146

This means now that there can be three individuals on each of the long seats and two on the shorter ones. Family households are encouraged to sit together. The stewards will remain available for assistance at each mass.
