Baptisms: The next celebration of Parish baptisms is on Saturday 18th September. Bookings are being taken for baptisms each month for the first and third Saturday. The next available free dates are on the 20th November. For the foreseeable future, attendance at baptisms is being limited to 10 people per baptism.
