### **HEALTH AND SAFETY:**

Since the change in the Health Guidance on the 6<sup>th</sup> September, we are permitted to have 50% of the capacity of St Teresa's present for services. This allows for 146 people. This means that there can be three individuals on each of the long seats and two on the shorter ones. Family households are encouraged to sit together. The usual routine of cleaning and disinfecting will continue. The stewards will remain available for assistance at each Mass.

The Health guidance for religious services and ceremonies will change on the 22<sup>nd</sup> October, in line with national guidelines. There is a growing sense within the faith community of St Teresa's that we will leave the seats in the church the way they are, that we continue with the distribution of communion the way we do now. We would welcome your views on this and please bring any concerns you may have to our attention.
