## MEASURES FOR RELIGIOUS SERVICES

The Parish Pastoral Council reviewed the current health measures in place given the announcement by the government on Friday 21<sup>st</sup> January, of the lifting of certain restrictions. In general terms we still think it prudent to take a cautious approach to the lifting of any measures. This is reflective of the comments we have received also from parishioners and friends since the government announcement. However, we cannot insist on any public health measures that the government has now lifted. Therefore:

- There is no requirement for social distancing indoors. Nevertheless, church congregations are still advised to spread out as much as possible and to be sensitive to the needs of everyone around them when choosing where to sit and kneel.
- Face masks are still required; as is hand sanitising when entering and exiting and to continue to use separate entrances and exits.
- The monthly practice of sanitising / spraying the church that has worked so well for us over the past two years will continue; as will the ventilation of the church before and after each service.
- The church pews will remain where they are for now, along with the same method for the distribution of communion.
- Please do not attend the church if you are experiencing any Covid-19 symptoms.
- We expect to receive in the near future, comprehensive guidance from the Diocese in relation to an appropriate timescale and procedure for the easing of all Covid-19 measures.
