

This week we gladly make available copies of "JOURNEY THROUGH THE PANDEMIC", the experience of life in the parish of St Teresa's during the Covid-19 pandemic 2020 - 2021. The book is an account, as the title says, of life in the parish during the pandemic, containing accounts, experiences, events, reflections, prayers, poems, supports, news & information and a diary as the pandemic unfolded in the parish, country and world. At the core of the book is the diary or chronicle kept by Fr Alois Greiler SM, since the first signs of the pandemic in Ireland, and secondly the contents of the Pastoral Parcel Newsletters distributed within the parish during the lockdowns. ### ST PETER CHANEL STATUE

On Thursday, the feast of the Epiphany of the Lord, the mass included the installation of a new statue of the Marist Saint PETER CHANEL, very kindly donated by the McQuaide family in the parish. It is a very generous and special donation and a wonderful addition to the parish. We hope that this new statue will be a source of grace and blessing for the intentions of many generations of parishioners, friends and passers-by who visit the church. For the moment the statue is on a temporary stand while a new and fitting pedestal is on the way. The feastday of St Peter Chanel is on the 28<sup>th</sup> April.

### STATIONS OF THE CROSS

You may have noticed one missing, the 7<sup>th</sup>. It is away to be restored: cleaned, touched up and to repair any broken plaster. Over the next month they will all disappear for similar renewal. The restoration work is being done by a specialist restorer: **Sophie Reynolds-Lerner**, and is being funded by a parishioner. The small replacement Station of the Cross is a work of Peter Browne, a former resident of Weir Home who died in May 2020 and who has donated a set of the Stations to the Parish.
