MEASURES FOR RELIGIOUS SERVICES

In general terms the Parish Pastoral Council think it prudent to take a cautious approach to the lifting of church health measures. This also reflects comments received from parishioners & friends since the government announcement. However, we cannot insist on health measures that have now been lifted. Therefore:

- *There is no requirement for social distancing indoors. Nevertheless, church congregations are still advised to spread out and to be sensitive to the needs of everyone around them.*
- *Face masks are still required; as is hand sanitising when entering and exiting, and to continue to use separate entrances and exists.*
- *The monthly practice of sanitising / spraying the church will continue; as will the ventilation of the church before and after each service.*
- *The church pews will remain where they are for now, along with the same method for the distribution of communion.*
- *Please do not attend the church if you are experiencing any Covid-19 symptoms.*
- *We expect to receive in the near future, further guidance (including timeframes) from the Diocese for the easing of all Covid-19 measures.*
