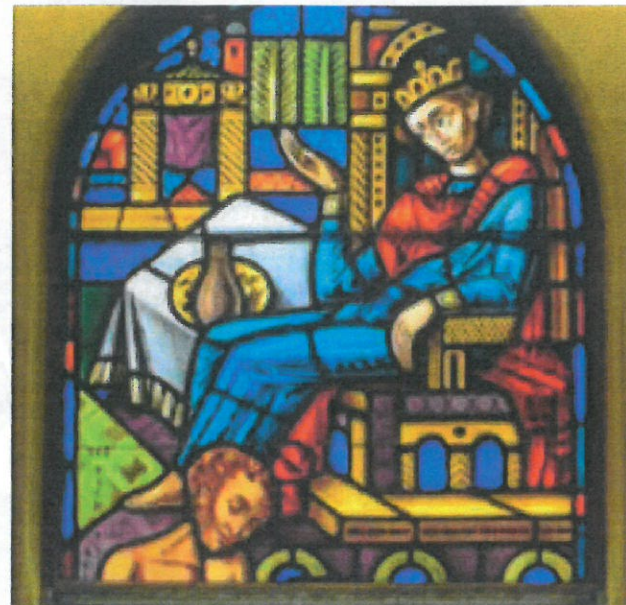

Among the items discussed was the progress made & required next steps for two new **Stained-Glass Windows** to commemorate the Covid pandemic. We are working with Abbey Stained Glass Studios and have now agreed the window designs. A sub-committee of the PPC worked on this throughout the summer. In addition to agreeing the designs, there are two further processes we need to complete:

- A submission to the Dublin Diocese (submission made & we await the outcome & their response).
