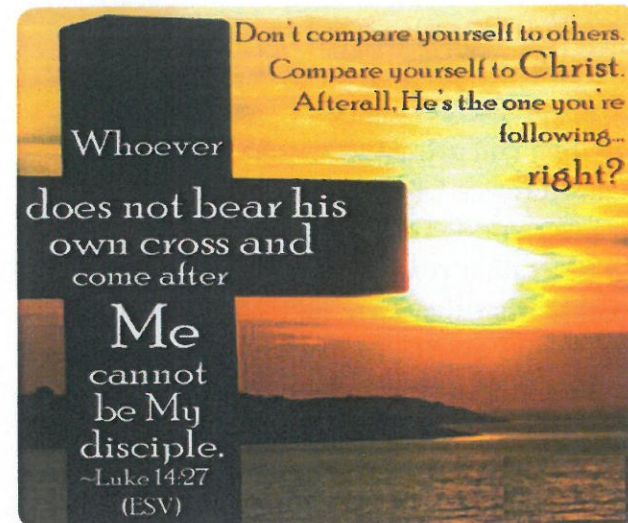

#### DONORE YOUTH AND COMMUNITY CENTRE - PROTEST

A demonstration will take place at **City hall, Dame St. at 5.30pm, this Monday 5<sup>th</sup> September 2022**, to highlight the lack of progress on the repair and re-opening of the Donore Youth and Community Centre, since the fire in June 2021. Including the pandemic, the fire and the current schedule for repair, the centre will be closed for a total of five years. The demonstration will emphasise the need for interim community spaces for the community to meet; and that DCC need to speed up the repair schedule. We need to show DCC how much we need a community centre NOW. Lets come together in a strong show of support for our community on Monday.
