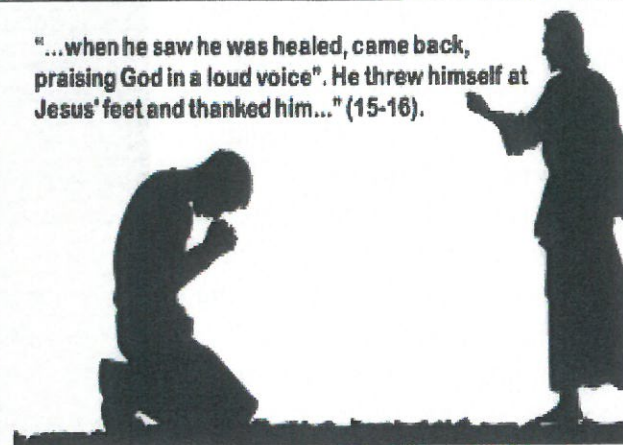

HARVEST SUNDAY: Penny Dinners

Next weekend 15th & 16th October, we celebrate Harvest Sunday. It is a time to give thanks to the Lord that we have food on our tables. Like last year, in lieu of asking for donations of fruit and vegetables for those less fortunate than ourselves we will place a box in the centre of the Church for donations to The Penny Dinners in Meath Street – also known as *The Little Flower Penny Dinners*. It was established in 1912 by the local parish and community in response to the high levels of poverty in the area and to provide food for those in need. The charity was named in honour of St. Teresa of Lisieux, widely known as the Little Flower; and started with donations from local parishioners of one penny per week. Hence the name The Little Flower Penny Dinners. **So this will take place next weekend.**

ANDREJ KAPAC

Andrej has returned to Slovakia. Many of you would have met Andrej over the past four months. He came to Donore from Slovakia to "come and see" and try out a possible vocation to religious life.
