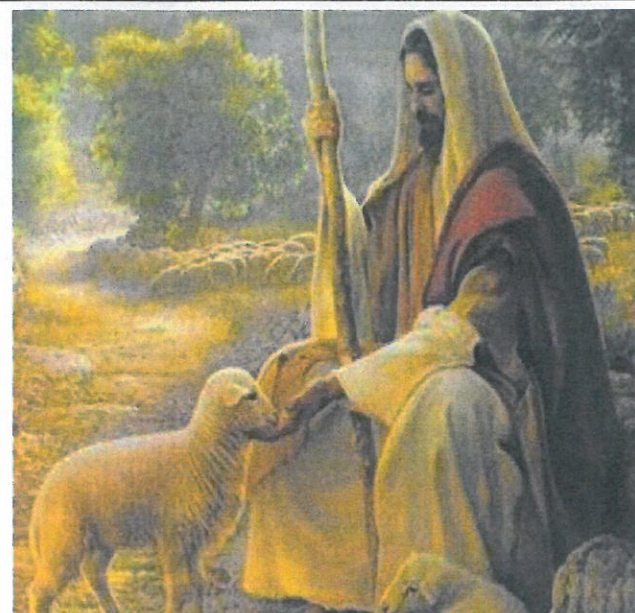

Sunday 29th January 2023 in St Teresa's – is a day dedicated to raise funds for **DEBRA Ireland**, which is a national Irish charity, established to provide support services to patients and families living with the debilitating skin condition epidermolysis bullosa (EB).

There will be a special collection at all the weekend masses.

In the afternoon at 2.30 pm there will be a showing of the film "The Two Popes", at which cocktail sausages/sandwiches/tea/coffee will be served. Come along for a nice relaxing afternoon together. There will also be an opportunity to donate to DEBRA in the afternoon.

DEBRA was established in 1988 by the patients and families of those living with EB to provide hope and support to those living with EB. There are currently 300 people living in Ireland living with the condition. DEBRA Ireland provides support not only to them but to their families who regularly act as carers.
