'People of Hope' - Lenten Reflection Sessions

The Season of Lent is a really good time for reflection
and to devote time to our faith life. The 'People of
Hope' Lenten reflection sessions are here to support
our parish, as we move forward in the Building Hope
initiative in the Diocese. 'People of Hope' sessions are
small groups who gather in the parish house to hear
the Scripture of the Sundays throughout Lent and to
reflect on what they mean to us through reflection,
prayer, and faith sharing.

People will be asked to commit to one session per
week over the 6 weeks of Lent. There are three
opportunities for people to avail of a session each
week – **Tuesday evenings at 6.30pm, Thursday
mornings at 10.30am and Sunday mornings following
the 11 Mass (approx. 11.50am)** Each session will take
place in the parish house and will last for one hour.
Refreshments will be provided. Each session can
facilitate a max of 8 people so please sign up with your
