Bishop Eamonn Walsh has accepted an invitation to celebrate mass in the parish at 12.30pm next weekend on Pentecost Sunday. **This is a mass to acknowledge the parish and community experience of the Pandemic Covid 19 and to remember all those who died over that period.** The new stained glass windows have been installed in time for this mass.

Groups have been working on various elements of the mass and all volunteers are very welcome:

- **the liturgy for the day;** Sam Byrne and Dee Kinahan are particularly looking for volunteers to read prayers in their native language to reflect: *"They were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in many languages as the Spirit gave them the gift of speech"* (Acts of the Apostles 2:4)

- **publicity and communication for the event.** Niamh McInerney, David Corrigan and Michael O Reilly: invitations have gone out to all families whose loved one's funeral took place in St Teresa's since March 2020. - **Church presentation:** the Altar Society cleaning groups ensure that the church is in its usual pristine condition.
