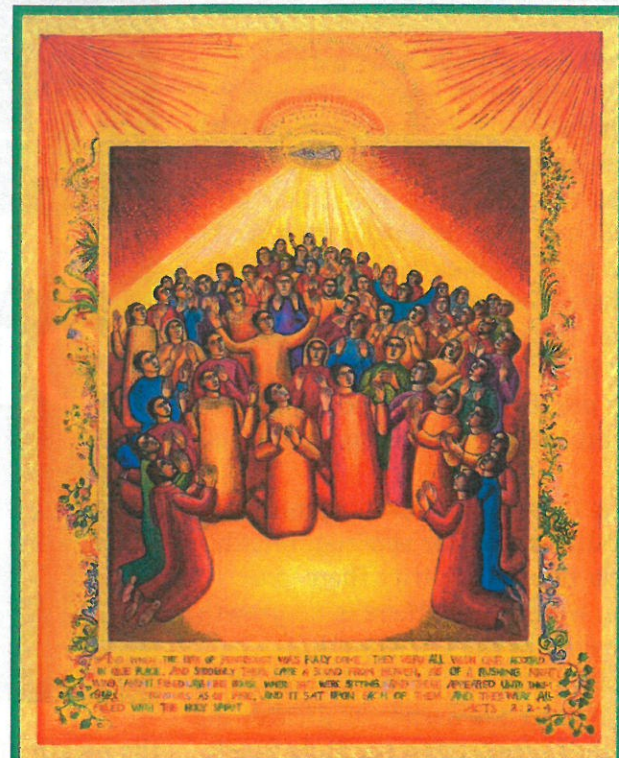

PENTECOST SUNDAY

Today at the 12.30pm mass we mark the experience of the parish during the Covid 19 Pandemic. The great way in which the local community rallied around to offer support, care, hope and assistance in so many ways. We also remember all those who died over that period from March 2020 to May 2023.

- The New Stained Glass Windows have been installed and will be a permanent memorial, to honour that experience. We want to thank the PPC, the subgroup of the PPC, those we consulted along the way, Abbey Stained Glass Studies and our donors who have contributed towards the cost. A beautiful leaflet has been specially prepared for you to take home as a memento of the day and the windows.
- Our mass today, is an opportunity to give thanks to God and to each other for the graces and blessings received over this time; to pray for and acknowledge the great suffering and loss endured during this time, and to implore God's blessing on all of us and our needs for the future. We thank Bishop Emeritus Eamonn Walsh for being with us today and everyone who has come together to prepare this day.
- St Patricks Shrine became the focus of remembrance for all those who died over this period. Today the stars from that shrine are available for families to take home if they wish.
- The book "Journey through the Pandemic" the experience of life in the parish during the Covid 19 Pandemic is also available on the tables in the church at a cost of €10, which will go towards offsetting the cost of the windows.
