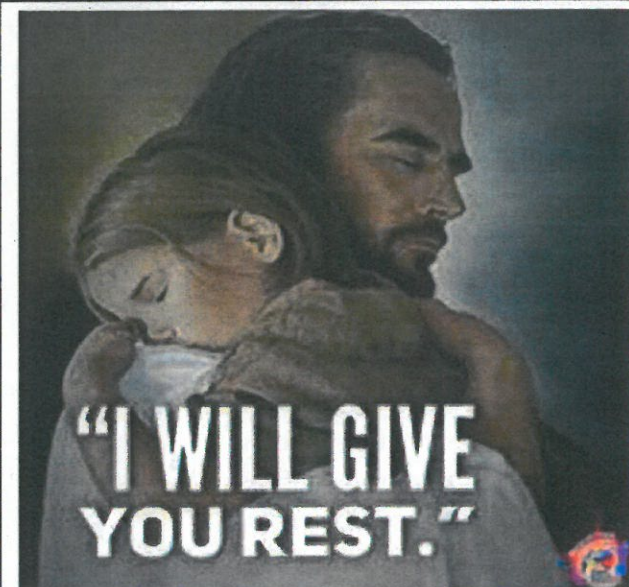

UPDATE ON DONORE YOUTH AND COMMUNITY CENTRE - 5TH MAY 2023

The design team, led by Cotter Naessens, are now developing a full scope of works through the examination of the building fabric, to clearly identify what is sound and what will need replacement.

Some initial clean up works have commenced and will continue in the coming weeks. A full inventory has been completed, and following the appointment of a strip works contract, a full scope of works will be determined.

It is anticipated, subject to tender submission being received that these strip out works will be completed in July. Once these strip out works have been completed the design team will develop a detailed schedule of works for the main construction phase.

We will also be in a position at that stage to provide an accurate programme for the works and reopening of Donore Youth and community Centre.

Ongoing meetings have been taking place between DCC and the insurance providers and this communication will continue through out the process to establish repair works and ensure design, procurement and construction works can proceed with the utmost efficiency.

DCC will provide regular update to the Are Committee and Community Stakeholders throughout this process. Trevor Higgins
