DONORE YOUTH AND COMMUNITY CENTRE

The design team, led by Cotter Naessens, are advancing the development of a full scope of works through the examination of the building fabric, to clearly identify what is sound and what will need replacement. Some initial clean up works have already been completed. Following a tender invitation and evaluation process, now completed, DCC have now appointed a contractor to undertake a full strip out of fire damaged areas and prop floors/ceilings as required.

This work will begin in the coming weeks and will take 3-4 weeks to complete and is made up of, Weeks 1-2 temporary propping and clearing, Week 3 site investigations & strip out and Week 4 design team inspections and review.

Once these works have been completed, the design team will develop a detailed schedule of works for the main construction phase. We will also be in a position at that stage to provide an accurate programme for the works and reopening of Donore Youth and Community Centre. Ongoing meetings have been taking place between DCC, Cotter and Naessens and the insurance providers, and this communication will be continued throughout the process to establish repair work and ensure design, procurement and construction works can proceed with the utmost efficiency. DCC will provide regular updates to the Area Committee throughout this process.
