

The plant's vibrant red leaves represent the blood of Christ, while its green foliage symbolises everlasting life. A Mexican legend tells of a girl who could only offer weeds as a gift to Jesus on Christmas Eve, and the poinsettia is interpreted as a symbol of the Star of Bethlehem.
