



In the past week there were meetings of the Parish Pastoral Council, Liturgy Committee and Finance

The Pastoral Council reviewed all elements of the planned parish building developments in the light of the immanent building developments to take place in Player Wills and St Teresa's Gardens; Parish Policy for the recordings of funerals; parish practice in relation to inclusion, communication & participation.

The Liturgy Committee reviewed major recent liturgies and planned for forthcoming ones, with particular reference to the Lay Led Celebration of the Word and Communion Service on Thursdays.

The Finance committee reviewed the first three months accounts for 2024; planned for the distribution of an income and expenditure account next week and also for the highlighting of locations within the church for donations to St Teresa's Parish and the Dublin Diocese.
