

STAINED GLASS WINDOWS

Have you noticed the extra natural light in the Shrine to St Jospeh? Abbey Stained Glass Studios in Kilmainham are restoring the three stained glass Windows in this shrine. Their absence is like as if the prayer space is no longer enclosed as it should be. These are the stained glass Windows most exposed to the heat of the Sun. Over the years, direct sunlight and heat has the effect of buckling the Windows leading to cracks and sometimes breakages.

CHURCH GAS HEATERS

The gas heaters in the church are over 40 yrs old. Over recent years five have been replaced. We are waiting for a further two to be delivered. Hopefully the weather will be kind to us until then.

CHURCH SEAT KNEELERS will continue to be reupholstered over time. The goal is to have all those in the centre of the church completed this year.
